### Balance brought forward

This is your previous bill balance. If it's already been settled, that payment is reflected here.

### KPLC CHARGES

#### Fixed Charge

This cost goes towards making the service available, including installation and maintenance of poles, power lines and equipment, and 24-hour customer care.

#### Consumption

This is your electricity consumption within the billing period. One unit is equivalent to one kilowatt hour. A kilowatt hour is equal to 1,000 watts of power used for one hour. KPLC also uses part of this money to procure bulk power from electricity generating companies, which it retails to its customers.

### GOVERNMENT TAXES AND THIRD PARTY LEVIES

#### Fuel Cost Charge

This money is collected by KPLC and all of it is passed on directly to electricity generating companies, who in turn pay fuel suppliers.

The money does not constitute any income to KPLC. The fuel charge is related to international fuel prices as well as the quantity of oil used for generation of thermal power.

#### Forex Adjustment

The foreign exchange component is related to the fluctuation of hard currencies against the Kenya Shilling for expenditure related to the power sector (e.g. project loan repayments).

#### ERC Levy

This levy is passed on to the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), the regulatory arm of the energy sector. It is currently set at 3 cents per kilowatt hour.

#### REP Levy (5% of the cost of the units consumed)

This levy is passed on to the Rural Electrification Authority (REA) for implementation of rural electrification projects.

#### VAT (16%)

This statutory levy amounting to 16 percent of the total bill is passed on to the Kenya Revenue Authority.

#### Total Amount

This is the total amount due and is payable within the period stipulated in the bill.
