Heavy Storm Disrupts City Power Supply

Power supply in parts of Nairobi was interrupted after a heavy storm affected The Kenya Power & Lighting Company Ltd. (KPLC) installations in various parts of the city.

Parts of the Nairobi Central Business District were affected after the storm broke poles a 66 kV high voltage line serving Jevanjee substation.

In addition, a billboard fell on a 66 kV line on Mbagathi Way, disrupting electricity supply to Ngong town, Kiserian, Rongai and Magadi Soda.

The storm also disrupted feeders serving customers in Kayole, Korogocho, Baba Ndogo, Muthaiga, Eastleigh, Kitisuru, Kyuna, Loresho, South B, South C, Nairobi West, Dam and Kimathi estates.

KPLC has mobilised operations and maintenance teams to commence repairs on the affected lines and installations to ensure supply is restored between 4 and 6 hours.
