Following requests for clarifications arising from prospective bidders and at our own initiative, we wish to make the following amendments to the Principal Expression of Interest (*hereinafter abbreviated as the PEOI*) for Request of Expression of Interest for Shortlisting of E-Mobility Technology Partners to Develop and Implement the Kenya Power E-Mobility Proof of Concept.

1. RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRINCIPAL TENDER DOCUMENT

Save where expressly amended by the terms of this Addendum, the PEOI shall continue to be in full force and effect. The provisions of this addendum shall be deemed to have been incorporated in and shall be read and constructed as part of the PEOI.

2. CLARIFICATIONS

The following clarifications have been made as hereunder:

No.	Question	Clarification
1.	Kindly register us as a company that will participate. Provide regular updates.	Kenya Power does not register suppliers rather register your firms on our SRM portal. From there, you will be able to participate in this tender. Go to our website www.kplc.co.ke and register from there. On your far right on the website you will find the SAP icon. Click on register and follow the prompts. Choose central office as your region.

No.	Question	Clarification
2.	Are international Companies allowed to bid?	International companies are allowed to bid individually or as a JV.
3.	Are 2W and 3W covered in the bidding?	The E-Mobility ecosystem will include support for 2 Wheelers (2W) and 3 Wheelers (3W).
4.	Are there any additional bidding documents?	There is no additional document. All the information is contained in the published REOI on the KPLC website (www.kplc.co.ke). To participate please read the Eligibility and qualifications criteria provided in the REOI and submit your documents in PDF format through the SAP supplier registration and logon portal on www.kplc.co.ke in order to be considered for shortlisting and qualification for the request for proposal.
5.	Is KPLC looking at installing Level 2 (AC Chargers) or Level 3 (DC fast chargers)?	The specific charges types will be defined at the RFP stage once KPLC has determined all the key requirements for the initial pilot phase (proof of concept).
6.	Any details of the payment/financial terms during the pilot?	At this stage KPLC is looking to shortlisted eligible bidders. The details of the payment/financial terms will be clearly spelt out at the RFP stage.
7.	How many locations would KPLC like to implement during the pilot in Nairobi and Nakuru? Any particular locations in mind?	The details of the number of locations in Nairobi and Nakuru will also be provided at the RFP stage.
