Procurement laws, Orders and Statutes have been enacted as partial requirement towards fulfilment of the provision as envisioned in the Constitution?

The Board, Management and Staff of the Kenya Power is committed to ensuring that the persons classified under Preference and Reservations in accordance to the Public Procurement & Asset Disposal Act 2015 get considered for the available business opportunities and the tenders they may wish to bid for at Kenya Power?

The categories in question include Youth, Women and Persons with Disability?

Thirty percent (30%) of our procurement budget has been set aside for the groups?

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO ACCESS KPLC PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES?

Action 1:

Registration as a supplier on Electronic Portal.

Access the tendering portal on www.kplc.co.ke by following the simple instructions on the icon:

NB: A prerequisite is to have a domain registered e-mail address. This is mandatory.

Action 2:

Company/Individual business Profile submission at any of the Kenya Power Offices:

Application to be included as “a Registered Supplier” may be made at anytime, at no cost and shall contain proof of the following:

- Area of interest (category) for provision of goods, works and or services
- Valid Tax Compliance Certificate
- Valid AGPO (Access to Government Procurement Opportunities) valid certificate
- Either certificate of registration as issued by the Registrar of Companies or
- Certificate of registration of business name
